

1 Corinthians 15:1-11

1 CORINTHIANS 15:1-11

- 1 Now, brothers, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand.
- 2 By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.

3 For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,

4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,

5 and that he appeared to Peter, and then to the Twelve. 6 After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep.

- 7 Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles, 8 and last of all he appeared to me also, as to one abnormally born.
- 9 For I am the least of the apostles and do not even deserve to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

10 But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not without effect. No, I worked harder than all of them—yet not I, but the grace of God that was with me.

11 Whether, then, it was I or they, this is what we preach, and this is what you believed.

Galatians 6:7

A TRUTH AT THE HEART OF HUMANITY

There are no good people

- Rom. 3:10; Eccl. 7:20
- We only feel good when we compare ourselves
 - How bad we *could* have been
 - How bad someone else is
- Compared to the Holy God, we all fall far short

PAUL ON "GOODNESS" ROMANS 7:18-19

"I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out.

For what I do is not the good I want to do; no, the evil I do not want to do—this I keep on doing."

PAUL'S DARK SIDE

1 COR. 15:9

Paul persecuted the church

Acts 8:3; 9:1-2

- In Jerusalem and Damascus
- Men and women
- Paul never recovered from his shame
- It became essential to his understanding of Christianity

PAUL'S TESTIMONY

13 Even though I was once a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent man, I was shown mercy because I acted in ignorance and unbelief.

14 The grace of our Lord was poured out on me abundantly, along with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus.

PAUL'S TESTIMONY (CONTINUED)

- •5 Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners—of whom I am the worst.
- •16 But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus might display his unlimited patience as an example for those who would believe on him and receive eternal life.

HEAR PAUL SPEAK TO THE CORINTHIANS

- He was a "good person" doing bad things
- He was not worthy to be an apostle 15:9
- But there was grace
 - Jesus died for our sins
 15:3
 - He was buried
 15:4
 - He was raised on the third day
 - Many people witnessed it

THE GRACE OF GOD

• "By the grace of God I am what I am"

15:10

- Paul let grace have an effect
 - He worked hard
 - Even the work was grace

LIFE LESSONS

- Are you a "good" person who does bad things?
 - Jesus died for your sins
 - He rose again
 - This living Christ offers grace
- Are you a "bad person" beyond God's love?
- We are saved by grace
- We live our new lives by the same grace

THE BIG IDEA

We are saved by grace

That same grace keeps enabling to work in his kingdom
